**Recommendations of Group 1:**

1. Local Governments should work under Provincial Governments
2. Old system of local governments should be reinstated
3. Local Governments should consult members of National and Provincial Assemblies in carrying out development work at district level
4. The Annual Performance Report of the District Coordinating Officers and the District Police Officers written by their respective district Nazims should also be countersigned by the MPAs
5. Maintenance of Law and Order should not be the responsibility of the District Nazim

### **Recommendations of Group 2:**

1. Power should be devolved from the centre to Provinces
2. Local Governments should work under Provincial Governments instead of the federal government
3. Maintenance of law and order should be the responsibility of the Provincial Governments
4. All departments in the provinces should be controlled by Provincial Governments
5. District Committees should have the authority of postings and transfer of Grade 1-9 employees
6. Rules and Regulations regarding working of local Governments should be devised by the Provincial Assembly or Provincial Government
7. The Annual Performance Review of the District Coordinating Officer should be written by the District Nazim
8. The departments of Health, Education, PHA; Communication & Works; Water And Sanitation Authority and Quetta Development Authority should be handed over to the provincial Government

### **Dissenting Views by Mr. Jan Mohammad Buledi, MPA**

1. All development work should be carried out under the oversight of District Governments
2. The responsibility of inside-district postings and transfer of grade 1-16 employees should rest with district governments
3. Provincial Governments should carry out postings and transfers of grade 16-21 employees in a district in consultation with the district Nazim
4. The development funds allocated to MNAs and MPAs should be used for development by the district government in consultation with the respective MNA and MPA
5. District Nazims should be given complete authority to maintain law and Order
6. Recruitment of Grade 1-9 employees should be carried out by District Committees while the authority to hire 9-17 grade employees should rest with Provincial Public Service Commissions
7. At the district level, the authority to levy and collect taxes should lie completely with the District Council
8. The transfers of all federal organisations employees such as WAPDA and T&T should be carried out in consultation with the district governments
9. Administrative ambiguities between District and Provincial Governments should be done away
10. District Governments should fall under Provincial Governments
11. District Nazim should have the responsibility to write Annual Performance Report of officers within that District
12. Provinces should be immediately given autonomy

**Dissenting Views by Moulvi Dur Mohammad, MPA**

1. Local Governments should be abolished
2. Local governments should be abolished as these are representatives of un-democratic governments
3. Or the district governments should be subordinated to Provincial Governments as that may improve [relations] between the two
4. The local government system should be the same as the old system
